We've seen lots of significant changes to Android over the past decade. For the first time in a long time, though, Android 12 actually feels like a whole new smartphone experience. That's because Android 12 is the first Android version in years to introduce sweeping changes to the software's front-facing appearance. The new Material You design standard represents a gigantic evolution for the way Android looks and what a device running the operating system is like to use. By and large, that evolution is a good thing. But with any progression comes certain quirks that don't always jibe with your day-to-day desires. For lots of folks, one such element is Android 12's adjusted approach to Quick Settings — y'know, that panel of fast-access tiles you can reach by swiping down from the top of your device's screen. That was certainly the case with one of my Android Intelligence Platinum members, who recently contacted me on my Platinum Help Desk with the desperate plea for a creative solution to help her customize her phone's Quick Settings and undo the "improvements" Android 12 introduced. Well, here's the good news — and the same thing I told her: As with most things in Android, the power to decide how you want your device to work ultimately resides in your hands. (Novel concept, no?) And if Android 12's Quick Settings setup isn't quite cuttin' it for ya, lemme tell ya: You've got a spectacularly simple way to flex that phone-owner muscle and take control. [Psst: Love shortcuts? The Android 12 Quick Settings conundrumAs you probably know, being the smart and exceptionally attractive lizard that you are, Android's Quick Settings area actually exists in two different forms. There's the full Quick Settings panel, which you find by swiping down twice from the top of your display (or swiping down once with two fingers side-by-side). And then there's the partial Quick Settings view, which shows up above your notifications when you swipe down a single time from the top of your suspiciously greasy screen. On earlier Android versions, that partial view allowed you to see and interact with six splendid shortcuts — whichever Quick Settings tiles were in the first six positions within that area: JR On Android 12, though, the tiles bulked up. And consequently, you can see only four shortcuts in that same amount of space. JR Is it party? Well, sure. But from a purely functional perspective, it's tough to deny that having fast access to only four items instead of six in the same amount of space is a bit of a regression. Now, you may well adjust to the change and not be bothered by it after a while. But if you really aren't feelin' the larger, less dense Quick Settings arrangement Android 12 introduces, there's a very effective way to eliminate it. The trick revolves around a fantastically useful app called Power Shade. It's a thoughtfully designed tool that lets you replace your device's entire default Quick Settings area with your own highly customized alternative — kind of like a custom Android launcher, only for Quick Settings instead of your home screen. And in fact, going back to the pre-Android-12, smaller Quick Settings style couldn't be much easier. If you fire Power Shade up and leave it with its out-of-the-box settings, it'll give you a shiny new Quick Settings panel that looks a lot like Google's older style — almost exactly what you're used to from Android 11 and earlier: JR Uncanny, right? And here's where things get especially nifty: If you want, from there, you can fine-tune and tweak practically every imaginable pixel of the Power Shade interface to make it look and work any way you like. I mean, this app's got options for everything: JR Heck, you could even expand the panel beyond those standard six first-swipe shortcuts and show even more tiles in that initial single-swipe view! JR Not too shabby, I say. So, yeah, Android 12-induced frustrations aside, this could bring some interesting little improvements in both visual appeal and efficiency in ways you weren't even expecting. Speaking of customization, one practical adjustment I'd strongly suggest making is tapping into Power Shade's extra Quick Settings gesture possibility. That makes it easier to get to your phone's Quick Settings panel without having to do that always-awkward smartphone hand yoga routine, and it helps with the occasional issue of the default Android Quick Settings panel popping up behind the Power Shade replacement (which, annoyingly, does seem to happen on occasion with this arrangement). All you've gotta do to activate that feature is: Open up Power Shade. Tap "Edge Triggers" in its main menu. Tap either "Left" (if you tend to hold your phone in your left person-paw) or "Right" (if you usually grip it with your right grabber). Flip the toggle next to "Enabled" into the on position. Once that's done, you can simply swipe your thumb down along the side edge of your screen — at whatever exact place you picked within that same setup area — to trigger your fancy new Quick Settings panel without having to reach all the way to the top of your screen. Capisce? Capisce. Now, before we call it a day and return to our respective snack mix consumption processes, let me mention a few important asterisks to this: First, most of the Power Shade basics will work for free. There's an optional premium upgrade if you want to unlock all the app's advanced options, but it's not at all required for the basic sort of stuff we're talking about today. Second, be aware: Going with a third-party setup like this will require you to give up the spiffy-looking Android 12 Material You theming within your Quick Settings area — the way that part of the interface automatically adjusts its coloring to match your current wallpaper at any given moment. An app like Power Shade could tie into that system eventually and act just like the default system-level setup, but as of now, it ain't gonna happen. And finally, by its nature, an app like this requires a fair number of permissions to operate — nothing alarming, but a level of access you may or may not feel comfortable granting. When you first set Power Shade up, you'll be prompted to allow it access as an Android accessibility service and to grant it the ability to read your notifications. The app wouldn't be able to do what it's doing without both of those being available, and its privacy policy is perfectly clear that nothing is ever collected, stored, or anything like that. Power Shade has also been around for a long time and has overwhelmingly positive ratings in the Play Store. Still, it warrants a mention that those permissions are there and that it's up to you to weigh 'em over. And with that, my goodness: Your Android phone's Quick Settings are now exactly the way you like 'em — recent design changes be damned. This innovative notification display, for which Google filed a patent in 2009, provides ongoing notifications from programs that run in the background. Other types of notifications that appear here include new message alerts, such as for incoming texts, email and Facebook messages, and notifications of new app updates. Pulling down the Notification bar to view status messages is a simple process that will become second nature once you've done it a few times. Confirm that your Android device is powered on and active. Unlock your screen if prompted. Place your fingertip gently anywhere on the Android home screen. Swipe your finger in a straight downward line to pull down the notification bar. Want to hide some of these settings, move them around, or add new ones? You can do that. The Quick Settings panel is something that often looks drastically different depending on your Android device, but the functionality is basically the same. We'll show you how it looks on a Google Pixel phone and Samsung Galaxy phone. RELATED: How to Disable the Mic and Camera from Android's Quick Settings How to Organize Quick Settings on a Google Pixel On a Google Pixel phone, one swipe down from the top of the screen reveals four Quick Settings tiles, and a second swipe shows eight. You can swipe horizontally to see even more. To add, remove, or rearrange the tiles, reveal the full Quick Settings panel and tap the pencil icon. The tiles at the top of the screen are in the Quick Settings area. You can touch and hold a tile to drag it around to a new spot or drag it to the bottom section to remove it. Lift your finger to drop the tile. In the same way, scroll to the bottom section to move unused tiles into the top Quick Settings section. When you're done doing all of your organization, tap the back arrow in the top left to finalize the positions. That's all there is to it. Just tap the pencil icon any time you want to switch things around. When you install an app that comes with a Quick Settings tile, it won't be added automatically. You can follow these steps to include it. How to Organize Quick Settings on a Samsung Galaxy On a Samsung Galaxy phone, one swipe down from the top of the screen shows six Quick Settings buttons (Samsung calls them "buttons" instead of "tiles"). A second swipe down reveals 12 buttons and you can swipe horizontally to see more. To add, remove, or rearrange the buttons, open the full Quick Settings panel and tap the three-dot menu icon in the top right. Select "Edit Buttons." The top section is "Available Buttons," these are not currently in the Quick Settings panel. Tap and hold a button to drag it to the bottom section to put it in the Quick Settings. Lift your finger to drop it. In the bottom section, tap and hold a button to move it around to a different spot or to the top section to remove it from the Quick Settings panel. When everything is looking like you want, tap "Done" at the bottom to finalize the placement of the buttons. That's it. You can go in and tweak the Quick Settings panel any time you want. Keep in mind that when you install an app that comes with a Quick Settings tile, it won't be added automatically. You'll need to follow these steps to include it.
